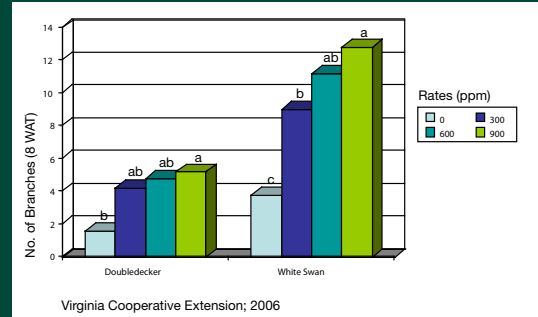

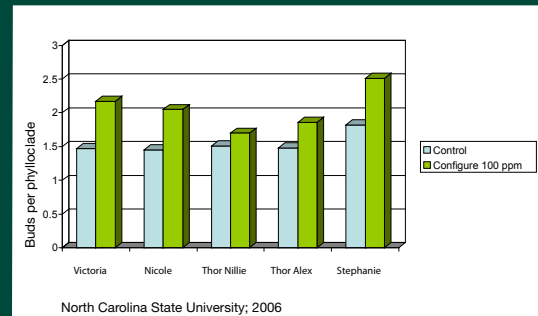

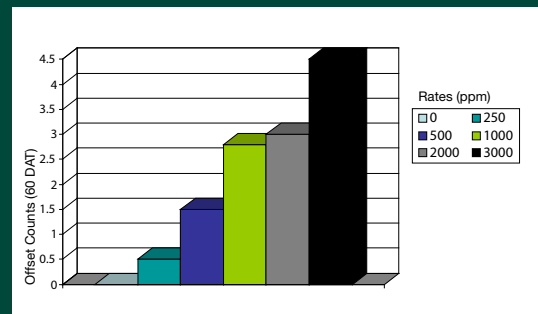
### Purple Coneflower (*Echinacea purpurea*)
